

## **Submission for symposia:**

BaCI invites proposals for symposia to be held during the BaCI 2019, which begins Tuesday, September 10, 2019. About ten symposia will be scheduled.

Symposia should deal with contemporary research topics in Basic and Clinical Multimodal Imaging research. Symposia can be organized along the lines of content (e.g., psychiatry, epilepsy, Alzheimer, cognition, brain stimulation, etc.) or methodology (e.g., EEG, MEG, fMRI, etc.) The recommended format of one symposia (80 minutes) is for four or five individual talks. Discussion time can be scheduled according to the organizers' discretion (e.g., after individual talks, concentrated at the end of a session, or a mixture of both). Both talk length and how discussion will be organized should be specified in the proposal. Other formats will be considered, but proposals for other formats should include a compelling rationale. Symposia often benefit from a diversity of perspectives and institutional affiliations. Proposals from young investigators are encouraged.

The symposium organizer and speakers are required to register for the meeting. Submitting a symposium proposal or speaking in a symposium does not prevent you from submitting an abstract for a talk or poster presentation at BaCI.

Organizers must ensure that all speakers are committed to participating in the symposium before submitting a proposal, and organizers must also ensure that speakers have not agreed to participate in more than one symposium. If a symposium talk has more than one author, it must be presented by the first author. Speakers may provide up to three references to published articles relevant to the proposed talk.

Proposals will be evaluated by the BaCI committee using a variety of criteria including scientific merit, timeliness, theoretical innovation and breadth, methodological innovation, lack of overlap with the regular program, and diversity of the speakers.

Speakers must reveal any commercial interests or other potential conflicts of interest that they have related to the work described. Any conflicts of interest must be declared on your title slide.
